

Quick Glance Cheat Sheet for AHA® Course Levels

Community Courses	Family and Friends CPR	Family members or friends and members of the general community who want to learn CPR skills but do not need a course completion card
	Family and Friends First Aid for Children	For those caring for infants and children such as family members, friends, babysitters and others members of the general community who want basic first aid information but do not need a course completion card
	Heartsaver CPR in the Schools	Middle and/or High School students seeking credentialed CPR and AED card
Health & Safety / Workplace Courses	Heartsaver CPR	For those who have a duty to respond to a cardiac emergency through job responsibilities or regulatory requirements.
	Heartsaver AED	For those who have a duty to respond to a cardiac emergency through job responsibilities or regulatory requirements.
	Heartsaver First Aid	For those who have a duty to respond to a cardiac and / or first aid emergency through job responsibilities or regulatory requirements.
	Heartsaver Pediatric First Aid	For those who have a duty to respond to a cardiac or first aid emergency through job responsibilities or regulatory requirements, such as: teachers, child care workers, school employees, foster parents, coaches, camp counselors, youth organizations, etc.
HCP	BLS for Healthcare Providers	EMS Personnel, PAs, Physicians, Dentists, Nurses, Respiratory Therapists, etc.
Advanced HCP	ACLS (Advanced Cardiac Life Support)	EMS Personnel, PAs, Physicians, Dentists, Nurses, Respiratory Therapists, etc.
	ACLS EP (ACLS for Experienced Providers)	Professionals, clinicians, scientists, etc. who respond to cardiovascular emergencies. For seasoned ACLS providers
	PALS (Pediatric Advanced Life Support)	Pediatricians, house staff, emergency physicians, nurses, paramedics, etc. providing care in pediatric emergencies.
